

## Scripture Nugget: Selflessness will reveal our true nature

I consider that the sufferings of this present time are as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us. For creation awaits with eager expectation the revelation of the children of God; for creation was made subject to futility, not of its own accord but because of the One Who subjected it, in hope that creation itself would be set free from slavery to corruption and share in the glorious freedom of the children of God (Romans 8:18-21).

In the fullness of time, when all sufferings cease and reign of God takes over completely, we, the children of God will be revealed as we truly are, with the freedom and glory that goes with being children of God. Transformed, we will be no less than like copies of Christ!! And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into His image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord ... (2 Corinthians 3:18).

To be transformed into images of Christ, we need to live our faith, walking in His footsteps, in allegiance to God's commandments in order that we may be led by Christ's Spirit, our interior Teacher. By His Word and deeds, Jesus teaches us to practise selflessness, doing everything with pure intention for the glory of God, and putting the interest of others ahead of that of ourselves. When He was on the Cross, enduring the excruciating pains of the Crucifixion, the desertion of most of His Apostles at a time when He needed them the most, and faced with the mocking taunts of onlookers to come down from the Cross to prove Himself, Jesus calmly responded by saying: "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing" (cf. Luke 23:34). In such a moment of need and pain, Jesus forgets Himself and garners all His remaining energy to ask His Heavenly Father for forgiveness of our sins. Thus, through the power of the graces He merited for us, we are empowered to do likewise, to rise above all our human frailty.

Selflessness will reveal my true self and the original nature God has created in me, His child with the glory and freedom that comes with it. Instill in my soul kindness, patience and perseverance.
